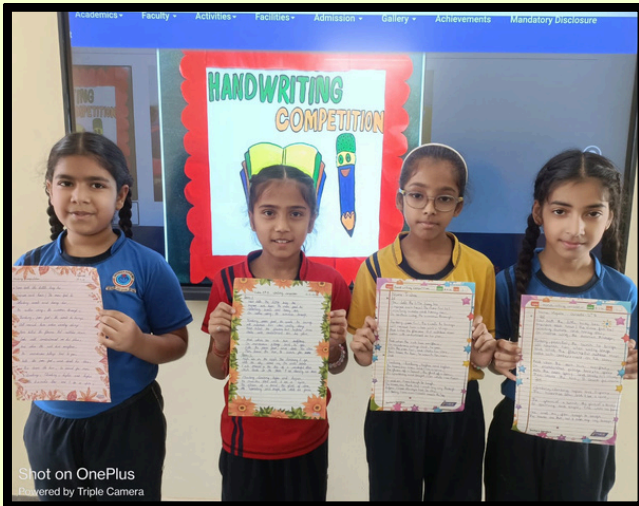
Session on Personality Development

Capacity Building Programme

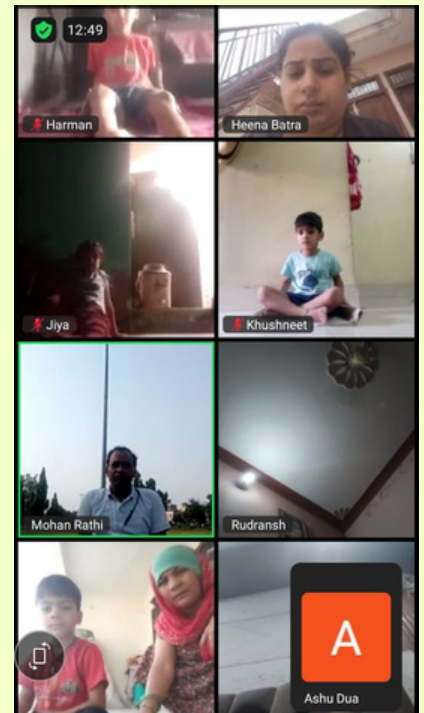
